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QUICK FAMILY SAFETY PLAN

Calm rules for kids, pets, and plants.

- 1) Look first.
- 2) Hands off.
- 3) Ask a grown-up.

Non-toxic doesn't mean edible. Don't taste any plant unless an adult says it's safe.

If something happens: stay calm

- Rinse with water** (mouth / skin / eyes)
- Tell an adult** right away
- Call Poison Control** (or a vet for pets)
Don't wait for symptoms.
- Call 911 for trouble breathing, fainting, or seizures.**

Home setup

- Put risky plants **up high / out of reach**
- Keep plant tools + bulbs/seed packets **out of reach**
- Wash hands before snacks and meals.
- Teach: **"I don't know it → look only."**
